
Berea Hardwoods Stainless Steel Folding Knife (Berea #DA30(S)



Needed: Mandrel-None Bushings-None Drill-1/8" & 5/32" Material Size- 3" X 1" x 1/4"

Preparing the Material Blank

- 1. Cut the material blank. You will need 2 of these.
- 2. Using the pattern below as a REFERENCE ONLY, saw out your blanks slightly larger than the pattern.
- 3. Carefully sand, file or saw the blanks until they fit the frame of the knife.
- 4. Now, using the template again drill the holes for the screws. There are 2 holes on one side and 3 on the other. The side with 3 holes is the one for the belt clip. The belt clip is optional. If you would rather make the knife without the belt clip them only drill 2 holes on the 3 hole side.
- 5. I used a 3/32" bit to drill the initial hole and then tried it on the blank to make sure the holes were in the right place.
- 6. Once they are adjusted properly drill through the blanks with the 1/8" drill.
- 7. Making sure you have the blanks oriented properly, left blank on the left and right on the right, drill a shallow step or counter sink slightly into the blank using a 5/32" bit.
- 8. Try the screw to make sure it is flush with the surface or slightly lower.
- 9. Continue drilling until the screws fit properly.
- 10. Taper, round, and texture your blank as you desire.
- 11. Sand and polish the blank to your satisfaction.
- 12. Finish the blank in your choice of finish.
- 13. Attach each blank to its respective side using the screws and wrench provided. Copyright Robert W. Keyes 2015
