Berea Hardwoods Napkin Ring Kit (11504NR-xxx)



Needed: Mandrel-1504NR/TL Bushings-None Needed Drill-30mm Forstner Bit

Wood Size- 1 ½" x 1" (maximum) You will also need a chuck for your lathe.

Preparing the Material Blank

- 1. Cut the material blank. You can use 2 narrow blanks, about 5/16" wide or 1 long blank up to 1" wide.
- 2. Drill the blank through the center, lengthwise, with a 30mm Forstner bit.



- 1. Assemble the blank on the mandrel as shown above.
- 2. If using the shorter blanks insert the supplied spacer between the 2 blanks.
- 3. Insert the mandrel into a chuck.
- 4. Turn the blank to the desired contour. NOTE: Slow down your lathe. This is a large blank so it should be turned at a slower speed.
- 5. TIP: I sawed off the corners slightly, but that is not necessary.
- 6. After turning the blank, sand the surface in progressive steps until you get to 400 or 500 grit.
- 7. If a higher polish finish is desired continue sanding with Micro Mesh through 12000 grit.
- 8. Apply the finish of your choice and polish.
- 9. Remove the blank from the mandrel.



Please refer to the Pen Parts diagram above.

- 1. Press the decorative rings into each opening in the blank. If they happen to be a little loose a drop of CA glue will fix them right up.
- 2. Now go find some napkins!!
